

All of the teaching resources that Sandvick uses are extremely useful and purposeful. What I find to be the most helpful are the midterm reviews before the midterms. The review sheets for tests were very helpful. The powerpoints used in class were also filled with all of the information we needed to succeed.

Professor Sandvick's material, the practice tests and slides, are helpful, but the textbook is not. It has good practice problems, but the way it explains concepts is strange and a little confusing. This makes the quizzes a little tedious and not necessarily a test of the material because you have to read the language of the textbook very carefully, even if you think you understand the concept. I basically took every quiz with the book open and it felt more like a reading quiz. The practice problems were good though and that is what helped me most in this class.
