

Overall, I would highly recommend Professor Sandvik to any of my peers who have not taken FINE 3010. (I also loved the quizzes and self learning videos which allows the students to have more flexibility) The only thing I would like to see a change in is the testing format (even though I understand this might be standard by department). I would love to see more opportunities for credit on longer word problems such as the full scale problem where a student might understand the process, however, receive no credit because of a small change in numbers or a change in steps. Also I would set aside one class just to go through the financial calculator more thoroughly. It was a huge help once i got the hang of it, but it did take some time for me to figure it out.
